CPS09/10 - 72      It was moved by Nash, supported by Collins, to approve the Memo of Understanding between Healthy Kids Dental and the County of Muskegon Juvenile Detention Center to provide dental services to the Medicaid eligible residents of the Muskegon County Juvenile Detention Center effective October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.

CPS09/10 - 73      It was moved by Nash, supported by Mahoney, to extend the current contract with Muskegon Family Care to provide medical services to the Muskegon County Juvenile Detention Center at the rate of Two Thousand and 00/100 (\$2,000) Dollars per month or the annualized rate of Twenty-Four Thousand and 00/100 (\$24,000.00) Dollars through September 30, 2011.
