MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Snider at 4:15 p.m.

ROLL CALL

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

It was moved by Engle, supported by Nash, to approve the minutes of the February 2, 2010, meeting as written. Motion Carried.

PRESENTATION

Lieutenant Brian Whitsett, Region 6 District Emergency Management Coordinator, presented Mr. Roy Wheeler with a Recognition from the Michigan Department of State Police Emergency Management & Homeland Security Division for his 60 years of service to the citizens of Muskegon County.

ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

CPS10/03 - 17 It was moved by Derezinski, supported by Mahoney, to approve the one-year extension of the agreement for the Partnership in Neighborhood Safety Program between the Townships of Laketon, Fruitland and Whitehall, the Muskegon County Sheriff and the Board of Commissioners with the county's share of the cost being 50% or \$114,158, and authorize the Board Chair and Sheriff to sign the document, contingent upon the approval of each of the townships. Motion Carried.

- CPS10/03 - 18 It was moved by Derezinski, supported by Engle, to authorize the Sheriff's Office to explore a contract with the other local fuel vendor who currently provides fuel to our marine division patrol boats, Merle Boes (Pacific Pride), Inc. Motion Carried.
- CPS10/03 - 19 It was moved by Derezinski, supported by Scolnik, to authorize the Sheriff's Office to change the funding for Sheriff Deputies #S05019 currently funded by Sheriff Operations 1010-0301 100% to Marine Division 1200-0331 100%, #S05005 currently funded by Sheriff Courts 1010-0355 100% to Sheriff Operations 1010-0301 100%, and #S05013 currently funded by Sheriff Courts 1010-0355 100% to Sheriff Operations 1010-0301 100% effective 2/13/10. Motion Carried.
- CPS10/03 - 20 It was moved by Derezinski, supported by Nash, to allow the Sheriff's Office to enter into an agreement with Propertyroom.com to provide the sales of evidence. Motion Carried.
- CPS10/03 - 21 It was moved by Nash, supported by Mahoney, to allow the Sheriff's Office to bid an engineering study to best determine the use of the vacant space in the county jail. Motion Carried.
- CPS10/03 - 22 It was moved by Nash, supported by Mahoney, to accept the Michigan Emergency Management Assistance Compact (MEMAC) Agreement between the State of Michigan and the County of Muskegon on behalf of the Sheriff Department/Emergency Services, and direct the Board Chair and appropriate staff to sign the agreement. Motion Carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Derezinski asked if the water safety program would continue with the recent retirement of Sergeant Berdinski. Sheriff Roesler noted the position has been filled with a transfer within his office and that program and marine patrol will continue.

NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Mahoney questioned any opposition to the zoning request from White River Township regarding the Coast Guard towers in the township. No opposition was voiced.
