

Filing Deadlines: Candidates

By 4:00 p.m., Tuesday May 15, 2012 Candidates for county convention delegate (precinct delegate) file an Affidavit of Identity for the August primary. Filing submitted to the clerk of the county, city or township in which candidate resides. Withdrawal deadline elapses at 4:00 p.m. on May 18. (168.624, 624a)

By 4:00 p.m., Tuesday May 15, 2012 Partisan and nonpartisan candidates (other than judicial candidates) file nominating petitions (or fees if applicable) and Affidavit of Identity for the August Primary. Withdrawal deadline elapses at 4:00 p.m. on May 18.

By 4:00 p.m., Tuesday May 15, 2012 Candidate without political party affiliation file qualifying petitions and Affidavit of Identity for the November general election. Withdrawal deadline elapses at 4:00 p.m. on July 23. (168.590c)
