ACT 114 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1979 REQUIRES SEPARATE EQUALIZATION OF EACH CLASS OF REAL PROPERTY. 2017 TAXABLE VALUE CHANGES ARE LIMITED TO THE INFLATION RATE OF 0.9% EXCLUSIVE OF ADDITIONS AND LOSSES.
