The Muskegon County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments on the above date, time, and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionments of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District.

The Water Resources Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day and make revisions to the apportionments where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance.

Comments on the Drainage District apportionments may be submitted to the Water Resources Commissioner in writing before the date of the Day of Review to 141 E Apple Ave, Muskegon, MI 49442, or electronically to [skoski@fsbirlaw.com](mailto:skoski@fsbirlaw.com). Comments may also be submitted in writing or verbally at the Day of Review. Comments submitted in advance must be received to the Water Resources Commissioner prior to the Day of Review to ensure consideration.

While this meeting is being held in-person for purposes of all applicable requirements under Michigan law, the Water Resources Commissioner nevertheless seeks to provide an opportunity for interested persons to attend and participate via remote electronic access, as a convenience. Subject to available technology, the Water Resources Commissioner will seek to provide an opportunity to attend remotely at the information below. Remote attendance is not guaranteed, however, as the in-person meeting is the only officially guaranteed means of participating.
