

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

2015-379 **AWARD THE BID FOR ANIMAL SHELTER SERVICES TO PUND BUDDIIES AND AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE THE CONTRACT AT THE FOLLOWING RATES: YEAR 1: \$140,000; YEAR 2: \$190,000; YEAR 3: \$325,000. FURTHERMORE, MOVE THAT THE INCREASE IN COST FOR ANIMAL SHELTER SERVICES OVER THE BUDGETED AMOUNT BE COVERED BY AN INCREASE ANIMAL LICENSE FEES TO BE BROUGHT FOR APPROVAL AT A LATER DATE**

The Administrator recommends, moved by Commissioner Lohman, seconded by Commissioner Mahoney, to award the bid for animal shelter services to Pound Buddies and authorize the County Administrator to negotiate the contract at the following rates:

Year 1:	\$140,000
Year 2:	\$190,000
Year 3:	\$325,000

Furthermore, move that the increase in cost for animal shelter services over the budgeted amount be covered by an increase animal license fees to be brought for approval at a later date.

Commissioner Hughes moved to amend the motion to include building improvements including replacing the roof and replacing the HVAC system.

The motion failed due to lack of a second.
