PUBLIC HEALTH ADVISORY

Public Health - Muskegon County, along with the City of Norton Shores, is issuing a public health advisory in response to a sanitary sewer overflow reported by the Muskegon County Resource Recovery Center (MCRRC). An upper limit of 87,400 gallons of raw sewage was released due to a valve failure. The spill occurred near a pumping station located near Airline Road and Getty Street. MCRRC reported that the failed valve was isolated immediately and repairs are underway.

As a precautionary measure, Muskegon County and Norton Shores residents are advised to:
Avoid direct contact with (or fishing in) Little Black Creek and Mona Lake
for the next 48 hours.
