

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
ON THE ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR  
FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026  
FOR THE COUNTY OF MUSKEGON

Please take notice that a public hearing will be held with the Muskegon County Board of Commissioners on the proposed FY2026 general operating budgets on Tuesday, September 9, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. at the Muskegon County Marquette Campus, The Meeting Place, located at 1903 Marquette Avenue, Muskegon, MI 49442.

**The property tax millage rate proposed to be levied to support the proposed budget will be a subject of this hearing. (FY2026 time period - October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026).**

The County must hold a public hearing before the final adoption of the budget. Any interested person will be given the opportunity to be heard at the public hearing regarding the proposed budget. A copy of the budget proposed for adoption including the authorized County operating property tax millage rate and proposed special operating property tax mileages rates, as reduced by Headlee, for the Lakeshore Museum Center, the Department of Veterans' Affairs, Muskegon County Central Dispatch, and PA39 of 1976 (Activities or Services for Older Persons Act) is available for public inspection on the County's website at [www.co.muskegon.mi.us/353/Budget](http://www.co.muskegon.mi.us/353/Budget).
