PROCEDURE TO EXEMPT (OPT OUT)
OF FRIEND OF THE COURT SERVICES

If you are initiating a divorce or child support proceeding, or have a pre-existing Child Support Order and you no longer want to receive Friend of the Court services, you must follow the instructions below:

1. Both parties must agree to opt out of Friend of the Court services.
2. Either party must complete the Motion and Affidavit to Opt Out of Friend of the Court services packet. It **MUST** be filled out completely, signed by both of the parties and notarized. **Submit the completed packet containing the following forms to the 3rd floor office of the Muskegon County Hall of Justice for approval. (May take up to 2 business days for review):**
 - 1) *Motion and Affidavit to Opt Out of Friend of the Court,*
 - 2) *Order Exempting Case from Friend of the Court Services,*
 - 3) *Certificate Exempting Case from FOC Services,*
 - 4) *No FOC Services Uniform Support Order,*
 - 5) *Uniform Child Support Order Deviation Addendum,* and
 - 6) *Advice of Rights Regarding the Use of Friend of the Court Services*
3. Once approved, packet will be emailed to you and you can file the packet with Circuit Court Records on the 6th floor of the Hall of Justice. If denied, instructions will also be included. There is a **\$20.00 Motion Fee and \$40.00 Order Fee** that must accompany your filed motion (if not being filed as part of divorce proceedings, where no additional fee is required).
4. Circuit Court will process your FOC Opt Out packet, and receipt your payment.
5. Once your packet has been accepted by Circuit Court Records, you will need to do nothing further.
6. You will receive a copy of the Judge signed Order in the mail, if approved.
7. If not approved by the Judge, a denial or hearing date for your appearance in court will be sent to you in the mail.
